





Valley Regional Occupational Program (ROP) offers a Health Careers pathway program where students can learn Medical Terminology and earn important industry certifications in order to become a Certified Nursing Asssitant.

Students first take the Medical Terminology class to get a foundation of medical knowledge. Students then take the "Certified Nursing Assistant" class during the Senior year.

Upon completion of the CNA course, students are able to take the State Certification exam and be certified by the Department of Health Services. The classes are designed to prepares students in core skills needed for more advanced courses in the health care careers.

Program Description

The Food Service and Hospitality pathway is designed to align career-path course work with current and projected employment opportunities.

Students pursuing this career pathway have in-depth, hands-on experiences that emphasize industry awareness; sanitation and safe food handling; food and beverage production; nutrition; food service management; and customer service.

The Culinary courses prepare students with entry-level skills that will enable them to seek employment in institutional, commercial or independently owned food establishments or other food and hospital. Students will develop these skills in a catering environment.







Valley ROP Program Description

Valley Regional Occupational Program (ROP) offers a Public Services pathway program where students can learn the basics of Criminal Justice (CJ), Crime Scene Investigation (CSI), and Bureau of Security Investigative Services (BSIS) Security Guard Training in order to become a Security Guard.

Students first take the "Criminal Justice" class during the Junior year, and the "Crime Scene Investigation" class as Seniors. The classes are designed to explain the hierarchy and inner-workings of the juvenile and adult criminal justice systems in California, and the study of criminal investigative techniques and analysis. The students can also take the Securuty Guard Training though their CSI or Adult School Class to obtain a certificate to become a Security Guard.


